This panel will bring together some of Canada's innovative presenters of new music together with representative composers and musicians to explore issues arising from presenting new music in unusual venues. The aim is to share experiences and foster new ideas and perhaps inspire both composers and presenters to think about the creation of music intended for community outreach.

This event is designed to showcase the original activities of a range of presenters and composers from across Canada (and beyond) seeking to find new ways and new places to present music and to engage the world around them. It is being held in conjunction with the *soundaXis* festival (June 1-11), a city-wide event celebrating architecture, music and acoustics.

The panel will be followed by a reception at 5:00 pm, hosted by the Canadian League of Composers. The presentation of the 2005 Friends of Canadian Music Award will be made during the reception. This \$1000 award is jointly sponsored by the Canadian Music Centre and the Canadian League of Composers.
